## If sentences



## Rules:

Condition: If + Subject + V ......

Consequence : Subject + V ......

If sentence: [If + Subject + V.... + Subject + V....

Or

Subject + V... + if + Subject + V....

#### Examples:

- *If* we *study* hard , we *will pass* the test . Or We will pass the test if we study hard .
- If you finish early, please come home quickly. Or Please come home quickly if you finish early
- *If* Ali *has* an exam , he *must prepare* well . Or Ali must prepare well if he has an exam
- -If they waste time, they may/might fail the test. Or They may/might fail the test if they waste time

Note: There must be a *comma* (,) between the two parts of the *conditional sentence when* we begin with the *condition part* (if clause). There is *no comma* when *if* is in the second part as in the examples above.

#### First conditional

If + Subject + verb ( present )..... + subject + will +verb (infinitive) ......

Or

Subject + will +verb (infinitive).... + if + Subject + verb (present).....

#### Example:

If we arrive early, we will visit the museum.

We *will visit* the museum *if* we *arrive* early .

## Second conditional

$$S + would + V (infinitive).... + if + S + V (past).....$$

## Example:

If we arrived early, we would visit the museum.

We would visit the museum if we arrived early.

#### Third conditional

If + S + had + 
$$V^r$$
 ( past participle )...+ S + would +have +  $V^r$  ( past participle ).....

Or

#### Example:

If we had arrived early, we would have visited the museum.

We would have visited the museum if we had arrived early.
