

**The attitudes of third grade secondary students
towards educational programs at Syrian
Educational Satellite Channel
A field study in public schools in Damascus city**

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ABSTRACT

This study aimed to identify the attitudes of 3rd grade secondary school students towards educational programs in Syrian Educational Satellite Channel according to the gender variables (female, male), specialty (scientific, literary). A scale of attitudes was applied on a random sample which consists of /328/ students from public high schools in Damascus city. The descriptive and analytical approach was used too.

The results of this study indicated that the sample attitudes towards the educational programs in the Educational Satellite channel are positive and clear in general. The results showed no statistically significant differences between the sample attitudes towards educational programs in the Educational Satellite channel according to the variables of gender, and specialty in general. But The results showed significant differences in sample attitudes between males whose specialty is literary and female, whose specialty is also literary, and the differences were in favor of the females. The results of the open questions found common problems among students related to educational programs, and to students suggestion.

The research conducted conclusions with suggestion based on the research results.
