

Anti-Israel forces In the United States of America

Abstract

The American political life and the system of government in which there is a wide field open the penetration of organizations and Jewish pressure upon the parts of the American state encompasses its three branches of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial. This prepares the appropriate climate for Zionist organizations to affect American society in many ways including political, economic, social, media and others. Allowing them the possibility of putting pressure upon organizations which may be opposed to its policies, in an effort to silence the voices of American and non-American (Arab, Jewish ..), and anyone who may be critical of American foreign policy towards the issues of the Arab region, as well as criticism of the aggressive Israeli policies toward the Arabs. Charles Mathias of Maryland, who was one of the most popular within the Senate, took the same line independent of his own Republican Party, when he said: *"The Israeli lobby is a stronger ethnic pressure group that is different from other groups in terms of their focus on vital national security issues. In terms of constant pressure it is doing more than others."* This is despite being exposed to American politicians and Jews, Arabs and Muslims and harassment and smear campaigns, resulting from their position of trying to get out of the circle of influence imposed by the Zionist lobbies in the United States. However, it has to be emphasized that the American people are increasingly aware of what is happening in the Middle East, and American public opinion has begun to become aware of the facts surrounding the conflict between Arabs and Israelis, albeit slowly. This is evidenced by the facts, especially after the invasion of Afghanistan in 2001; 2003 invasion of Iraq; and the war in July 2006, and the war in Gaza in 2008, as well as subsequent events of the developments, changes and repercussions which have proven the failure of American policy and contradictions in a lot of cases.

The foregoing may constitute a strong incentive to the adversarial forces of the Zionist entity in order to embrace and unite their efforts, so as to organize a broad and active voice inside the American society, where this can be established via media outlets, as well as political and cultural platforms that can reach the largest possible number of the American people, and thus work to change the American mood toward the issues of the Arab region, and to the benefit of their peoples.
