The "Adair Amila" hotel, which was built by the environmental expert Mounir Neamatullah, which is located in the Egyptian desert of Siwa, about 300 km from the Mediterranean coast to the southwest of Marsa Matrouh, is classified among the strangest and most beautiful natural tourism facades in the world.

It is a hotel built in the style of traditional Siwi houses, its walls are made of a stone archive that consists of salt and fine sand mixed with mud, while the doors and windows were made of palm tree wood and its walls are from salt rocks, as there are palm trees that enjoy the shade of the open courtyard of the hotel, as the hotel is With earthen doors that absorb heat during the day and then reflect at night to give warmth.

This experience in sustainable building is living proof of the possibility of using the vocabulary of nature creatively and creatively to reach such a sustainable environmental architectural product.
