



PROTOCOL OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
TECHNOLOGICAL EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OF THE
IONIAN ISLANDS – GREECE
AND THE DAMASCUS UNIVERSITY – SYRIA



ARTICLE 1: THE TARGETS

- Scientific and educational cooperation between the two institutions.
- Development of joint research initiatives and submission of joint proposals for funding to the EU or other International Organizations.
- Exchange of publications and PhD and Master thesis.
- Exchange of research and academic journals.

ARTICLE 2: CONTENT OF AGREEMENT

- Mutual exchange of research staff within a framework to be agreed.
- Organizing and coordination of the submission of research and development initiatives for funding.
- Participation of Damascus University faculty members in the Editorial, as well as the Scientific Committee of the "Review of Mediterranean Cultural Heritage".
- Organizing research projects in fields of common interest, carried out and supervised by the facilities and scientific expertise of both institutions.

ARTICLE 3: BINDING RULES

- This agreement shall be valid for a period of 5 years starting on the date that is authorized by both institutions, and could be renewed. Nevertheless, each of the above institutions has the rights to cancel the agreement with the other at least six months in advance with prior warning. The two parties can renew the agreement with the same or different rules, pending the signing of a new agreement.

ARTICLE 4: IMPLEMENTATION

- The two institutions have to formulate in advance a framework and subsequently submit an action plan, setting the rules which the article 2 will be satisfied.
- The two parties have to submit annually an account of their accomplishments within the framework of agreement.
